The EcPol’s thematic section on the Philosophy and History of Political Economy aims to organize conference panels on issues related to the philosophical, sociological and historical foundations of Political Economy.

We invite you to submit proposals addressing the themes in the general call of the Annual Meeting and promoting critical debate on central concepts such as values, institutions and markets, as well as on the methods and assumptions underpinning the analysis of economic phenomena. The goal of this call is also to encourage interdisciplinary exchanges and reflections in the field of Political Economy.

Given the general topic of the 8th Annual Meeting – “Political Economy for a Just Life”, we invite the submission of proposals focusing on any of the following topics:

- What is a fair, or just, economy?
- Political economy and theories of freedom
- Theories of justice and redistribution
- Philosophical foundations of economic theory
- Political Economy and rationality
- Historical perspectives on the development of liberal capitalism
- Crisis of neoliberal capitalism: is mainstream economics struggling?
- Ethics and the functioning of the economy
- Historical progress and economic development
- Varieties of Capitalism
- Markets, democracy and political economy
- History of State intervention: (de)regulation, planning, (re)distribution
- Historical perspectives on the Portuguese Economy
